Region	VIOLATED FACILITY REGION	Plain Text	Regional Board office that has primary responsibility for regulation of the facility: "1" – North Coast; "2" – San Francisco Bay; "3" – Central Coast; "4" – Los Angeles; "5F" – Central Valley (Fresno); "5R" – Central Valley (Redding); "5S" – Central Valley (Sacramento); "6" – Lahontan; "7" – Colorado River; "8" – Santa Ana; "9" – San Diego.
Facility ID	FACILITY_ID	Plain Text	System generated identifier of record representing the regulated facility.
Facility Name	FACILITY_NAME	Plain Text	Name of the regulated facility.
Agency	AGENCY_NAME	Plain Text	Organization responsible for the regulated facility.
Place Type	PLACE_TYPE	Plain Text	This field categorizes the regulated facility according to the primary activity of the facility. Place types are further categorized into more descriptive categories.
Place Subtype	PLACE_SUBTYPE	Plain Text	This field displays the lowest level of categorization that describes the primary activity at the regulated facility.
Facility Latitude	PLACE_LATITUDE	Number	Latitude used to map the regulated facility, expressed in degrees.
Facility Longitude	PLACE_LONGITUDE	Number	Longitude used to map the regulated facility, expressed in degrees.
Waste Discharge Identification Number	WDID	Plain Text	Identification number associated with a discharge.
Regulatory Measure ID	REG_MEAS_ID	Plain Text	Identification number associated to a regulatory measure. This is the action taken by the Water Boards that was violated.
Regulatory Measure Type	REG_MEAS_TYPE	Plain Text	The type of regulatory measure (such as permit, order, certification, enrollment under a general order) that was violated.
Violation ID	VIOLATION_ID	Plain Text	System generated identifier representing an instance of non-compliance.
Violation Type	VIOLATION_TYPE	Plain Text	Category of non-compliance. Violation type is further broken down into

			subtypes.
Violation Subtype	VIOLATION_SUBTYPE		The lowest division of violation categorization.
Violation Description	VIOLATION_DESCRIPTION	Plain Text	Summary of the non-compliance. For water quality violations, this field has been auto-generated since 2010 using the parameter/limit information entered. For other types of violations, this is a free-text field.
Violation Status	STATUS	Plain Text	Violation – Violations that require no further action. Potential – Used for records automatically generated by the Sanitary Sewer Overflow module of the system and that have not been updated by staff. Dismissed – Used to note that the violation is no longer valid.
Occurrence Date	OCCURRED_ON	Date & Time	The date that the violation actually occurred. For continuing violations, such as monthly average, this is the last day of the reporting period. For deficient or late reports, the occurrence date is the day after the report was due.
Program			The Water Boards has divided its workload into regulatory programs that are distinguishable by the type of discharge. The “program” field is the most discrete division.
Program Category			The Water Boards has divided its workload into regulatory programs that are distinguishable by the type of discharge. Each program category is further divided, which is found in the “program” field.
Parameter			Analyte that was the source of the violation. Applicable only to water quality violations.
Limit			Numeric limit contained in the order. Applicable only to water quality violations.
Result			Result of the calculation performed to determine compliance. Applicable only

			to water quality violations.
Units			Units of both the limit and result. Applicable only to water quality violations.
Limitation Period	PERIOD		The limit basis, such as monthly average or six-month median. Applicable only to water quality violations.
Monitoring Location			The monitoring location that is the source of the violation for those violations associated to a particular monitoring location.
Location			The latitude and longitude of the regulated facility.
